## Snowmobile Safety Training

Snowmobiling is a great way to enjoy the winter and even better when you do it safely.

Snowmobile safety training is encouraged for all snowmobile operators. These days snowmobiles are capable of high rates of speed over snow and ice. With the countless hazards associated with operating a snowmobile, training is a crucial factor in safe, responsible snowmobile operation.

## Classroom - Half Day

This half day classroom based course covers all aspects of snowmobile riding and is ideal for the beginner and novice driver.

Families are welcomed to attend. Students under 18 must be accompanied by a parent.



## Classroom & Practical - Full Day

Whether you're an experienced rider or it's your first year on the sled - this one day classroom and practical session is for you.

This full day program consists of three hours of in-class theory and three hours of practical. Each student is required to bring a fully licensed and mechanically sound snowmobile.

Students must be over the age of 14 to attend this course. If you are under 18 you are required to bring a parent or guardian.

Hands-on practical training will be done at a pre-determined location.

- Correct operating procedures
- Laws governing snowmobile operation
- Move off and stop
- Hill climbing
- Control and steering
- Braking and balancing techniques
- Safety checks
- Slow speed controls
- Appropriate attire
