Who Should Attend?

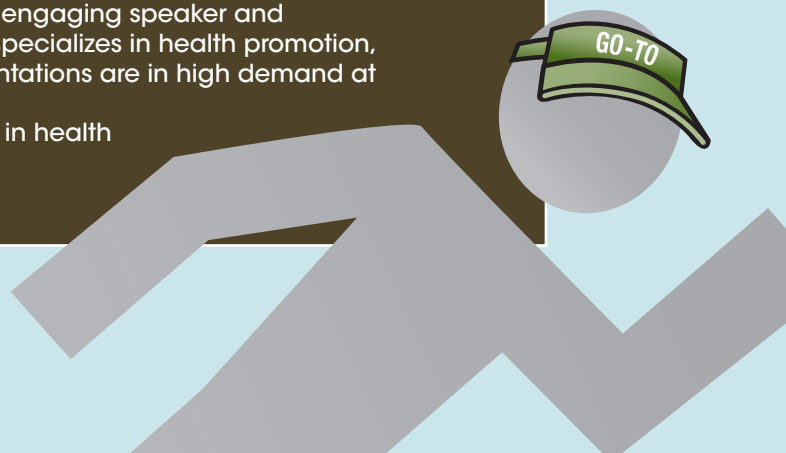
