What Is The Certified Pool-Spa Operator[®] (CPO[®]) Program?

The Certified Pool-Spa Operator[®] (CPO[®]) program has delivered more training than any other program in the pool and spa industry since 1972. In that time, more than 200,000 successful CPO[®] certifications have been awarded in 44 countries.

General Information About The CPO[®] Certification Program

- The CPO[®] certification program requires participation in a two day class taught by a certified instructor.

- The CPO[®] certification program requires an open book written examination. Participants must score 75% or higher to receive certification.
- The CPO[®] certification is valid for five years.

Successful course completion results in the student becoming a Certified Pool/Spa Operator by the National Swimming Pool Foundation ((NSPF[®]), located at 4775 Granby Circle, Colorado Springs, CO.

Certified operators will receive a certificate, suitable for framing, complete with your personal CPO[®] Registration Number, and a wallet certificate.

Certification is valid for a period of five (5) years from the date of course completion.
